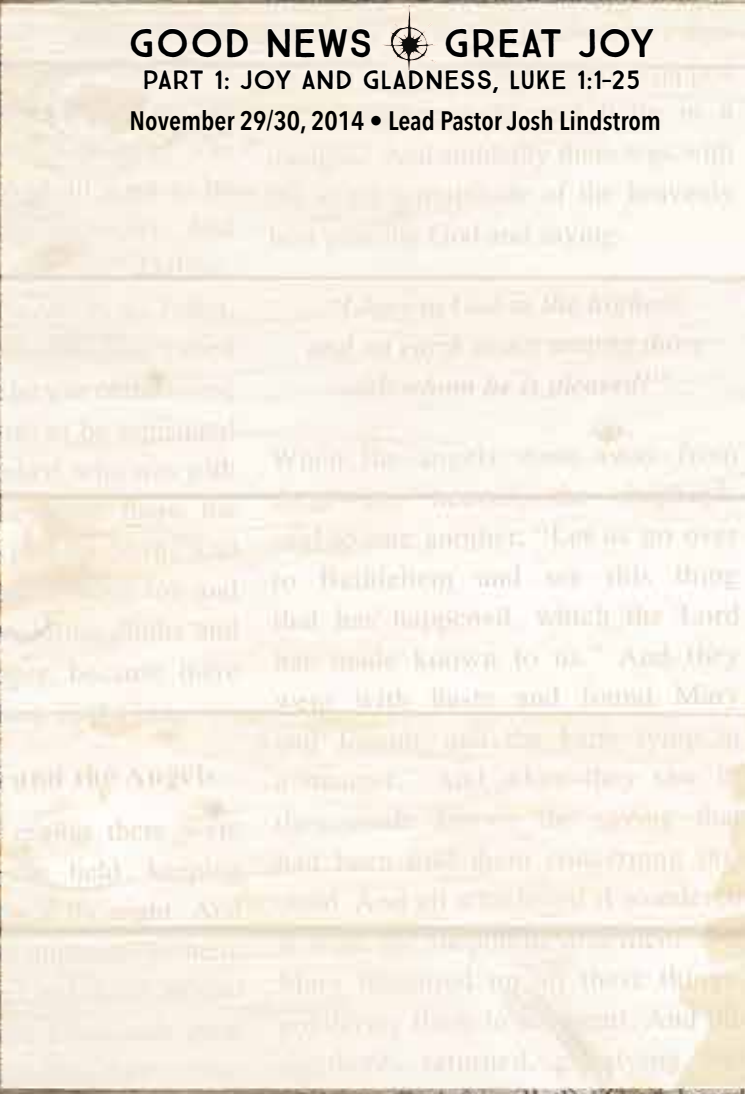

Did You Know ...

Although we did not increase this year's budget request, as we enter the final month of our fiscal year's first quarter we find ourselves \$143,777 behind in our budget need.

The October through December time period represents our "critical dependency" quarter and, as such, is used by both leadership and our ministries to determine whether or not to restrict/reduce our budget and ministry outreach.

As we enter the final weeks of the year, would you prayerfully consider how you may assist us in bridging the gap between giving and budget need by December 31?
