

Thanks again to all who participated in the Ten8cious Challenge. We received a few more gifts after last week's report for a final total of \$255,450! As we move into the last few months of our fiscal year - ending Sept 30, 2014 - we hope you will continue to respond to the call toward biblical stewardship that the Ten8cious Stewardship Challenge has highlighted:
